These segments of the 92X service operate direct from Mitchell P&R Lot to San Ramon **without** stopping at Walnut Creek BART in the AM or PM. The AM service drops riders at the San Ramon Transit Center, Chevron Park, and Bishop Ranch 1 before it continues on to pick up ACE patrons in Pleasanton and bring them to Bishop Ranch. In the evening, the 92X buses carry ACE patrons from Bishop Ranch to the ACE station. Then they return to Bishop Ranch to pick up north-bound Bishop Ranch employees wanting to return to Mitchell Park & Ride Lot.

It is VERY IMPORTANT to understand that ACE pays for the 92X bus as a dedicated service to carry riders between Walnut Creek, Danville, San Ramon & Pleasanton. **In the PM if the train is delayed on its way from San Jose to Pleasanton the 92X bus must wait up to 20 minutes for arriving trains before departing from Pleasanton.** While this is inconvenient, it is also an infrequent occurrence. Mitchell P&R Lot patrons should be aware of their other options to return to Mitchell in the PM. They can board a 96X bus to Walnut Creek and take route 93X, route 1 or route 7 from Walnut Creek BART to arrive at Mitchell. Their Bishop Ranch bus pass provides free passage on all of these routes. They can also sign up for ACE alerts, so they will know when an evening ACE train has been delayed between San Jose and Pleasanton.
